Once again, your attention is invited to the page addressing "Allgemeine Bestimmungen" (= Basic Information). The organizers will not accept incorrect preregistrations and will not commit themselves to reserving horse boxes. Incomplete nominations will not be considered in the catalog! Please also advise your trainers and demonstrators that the nominations and reservation of horse boxes will only be made after payment of the entry fee.

#### **Preamble**

In our dealings with horses, we take responsibility for living creatures that are entrusted to our care. At all events held at Marbach State Stud, we place great value on animals being treated in a manner suitable to their nature. Accordingly, we are strongly opposed to manipulation of a horse's performance by drugs or any other unsuitable means. A horse should treated according to its nature, its abilities, and its willingness. As humans we must act according to this reponsibility, always to the benefit of the horse. Marbach State Stud wishes all participants in the **Bairactar Memorial 2013** every success and joy.

#### International C-Show

#### Venue

The show will be held in the stud's large indoor arena.

# **Conditions of Entry C int. Show**

Open to horses that are registered in any WAHO recognized studbook by the closing date of entries.

## **Entry restrictions**

Title Show and A Show Champion Gold and Silver medal winners are not allowed to take part in a B show for the rest of that calendar year and the calendar following two years, unless the horse has passed from a junior to a senior category. Anybody entering an overqualified horse will be liable to a fine of € 600 and the horse will be disqualified.

# Judging system for classes (C int. show)

Each judge gives 1-10 points for the following criteria:

Three judges will judge each class independently of each other and without catalogue, giving 1-10 points for the following criteria: type (breed and gender), head & neck, body & topline, legs, movement (walk and trot). Half points are not allowed.

The final score is achieved by adding the total points, dividing the sum by the number of judges and transposing the result to the 100 points system. Classes with less than three entries will be combined with the next higher or lower class. Classes with more than 16 entries may be split.

#### Rules for ties

In the event of a tie in the qualifying places of a class, the higher place will be given to the horse with the most points for type. If there is still a tie, the higher place will be given to the

horse with the most points for movement. Failing a decision on either of these, one judge chosen by ballot will name his preference.

# **Qualification:**

The first three horses in each class are qualified for title shows and A shows.

# **Judging System for the Championships**

# **Rules for Championships**

- 1. With the exception of shows judged under the single judge system, Championships will be judged as follows:
  - a) The horses placed first in their class line up ordered according to age. The horses placed second in their class line up behind them in the same order.
  - b) The first placed horses will be judged individually, standing and trotting.
  - c) The judges will not discuss the horses.
  - d) The Champion Gold medal winner is selected from amongst the horses placed first in their class by individual written votes from each judge. The best placed horse will be Champion Gold medal winner. In the event of a tie, the horse that received the highest number of points in its class will be declared Champion Gold medal winner. In the event of a further tie, the "Rules for Ties in Qualifying Places" will apply. The Silver medal winner will be selected in the same way as the Gold medalist from all other horses that have qualified for the Championship.
- 2. The Bronze medal winner will be selected using the same system used to select the Silver medalist.
  - The votes of the judges in the Championships will be announced and will be published at the show office immediately after the judging has finished.
- 3. A fourth horse will be selected, which will become the Bronze medal winner should one of the three medal winners be disqualified. If this exhibit is not apparent from the voting papers, the judges will be asked to nominate one. This horse will not be announced. In the event that two or more of the medal winners are disqualified, no further substitution will be made.
- 4. If a horse placed first in its class is not able to take part in the Championship, the horse placed second in the class will move forward and be judged with the other horses placed first. Should a horse placed first be sent out of the ring by the judges for any reason, it will be deemed to have taken part in the championship and, therefore, the second placed horse will not be judged with the other first placed horses. Substitutions for absent first-placed or second-placed horses by third-placed or lower-ranked horses will not be permitted.
- 5. All horses that qualify for their respective Championships must take part in the Championship. Unless a certificate from the DC veterinarian is produced, failure to compete will disqualify the horse from the show, with its record of score and class placing being deleted and the horse being disqualified from showing for the period of one year as from the date of the show. In the event of a disqualification, horses placed behind the disqualified horse will move up a place in the class but not be entitled to enter the Championship.

The rules set down in the Blue Book 1010 of the EAHSC apply in every aspect. In case of doubt or differing opinions, the original English version applies.

#### **BREEDER'S CUP**

The horse with the highest score whose owner is also its breeder, will win the "BREEDER`S CUP".

# 15 Weil Marbach-Cup

Open to all purebred Arabian stallions and mare of two years and older with a minimum of 50 % Weil-Marbach blood (in case of doubt, please inquire). If sufficient entries are being received, stallions and mares will be judged seperately. There is no entry fee for horses that start in the C show.

### **Judging System Weil Marbach-Cup**

Same as C show. The winner will be "Weil Marbach Champion"

# 16 Judging System for Liberty Class

Three judges will judge this class independently without a catalogue by the following criteria:

**Type** –multiplied by 2, **overall impression** – multiplied by 1, **movement** – multiplied by 3. The horse with the highest score will be named "Marbach Liberty Champion 2013". The number of competitors in the liberty class is restricted. Permission to start will be given in order of entries received. **No more than 2 people are allowed in the ring per horse.** 

# 17, 18, 19 Sporthorse classes

Open to horses with Arabian Pedigree (ox, ShA, A, AA, APb) with confirmed performance record in sports disciplines, such as endurance, racing, dressage, jumping, Western or stallion/mare performance test. In case of too few entries, classes 17, 18, and 19 will be merged.

### **Judging system Sporthorse classes**

The same as in C show. There will be special prices given, but the result does not qualify for the championships.

# **General Regulations**

#### 1. Basic Rules

- **1.1** The ECAHO show rules and regulations apply in their entirety (enclosed).
- 1.2 On submitting the entry forms, all exhibitors, their agents, and associates agree to unconditionally accept these regulations and to follow the organiser's instructions
- 1.3 All exhibitors will accept the judges' decisions, which are limited to this show and based on the judging system laid down in the regulations. The judges are invited by the organiser, are not paid, and are not commissioned by their breed societies.
- 1.4 The judges' decisions are final and will not be contested. The judges are not liable for any consequences resulting from their decisions.
- 1.5 All horses must be free of contagious diseases and come from a non-infected stable.

  They must be <u>effectively</u> vaccinated against EQUINE INFLUENZA, i.e. they will only be permitted to take part if the following is documented in their passports:
  - a) Basic immunisation: a primary course of two vaccination doses administered a minimum of 42 and a maximum of 70 days apart. A third dose must have been administered 6 months (+/- 21 days) after the second vaccination of the primary course.
  - b) Booster vaccinations: booster vaccinations must be administered after 6 months (+/- 21 days).

# Horses may participate in the show if:

- 1. the primary course of two vaccinations has been administered, 14 days having past since the second vaccination.
- 2. the last booster vaccination has been administered no less than 7 days ago and after an interval up at most 7 months + 21 days.

The equine passport must be presented at the show office. In case of a missing vaccination pass, or any suspicion of contagious disease, the organiser may have the horse examined by a veterinarian at the owner's costs. The organiser is entitled to have the horse quarantined according the the veterinarian's decision. It is strongly advised to vaccinate against virus abort.

Note: Accordance to the Rules for Medication Control and IV. Addendum

- 1.6 The organiser accepts no responsibility for accidents, illnesses, theft, fire, or any kind of damage, whether to people or to animals and objects, in particular, no third party liability for any damages. The owners of all horses or other animals at the show must have legal liability. Everyone is personally responsible for damages to third parties caused by himself, his associates etc., or his horses.

  Any alterations/damages to the stable tents and other equipment will lead to exclusion, and the person responsible will be held liable!
- **1.7** Horses coming from abroad must be accompanied by the appropriate health certificates according to EU regulations. The relevant information is available at the veterinary departments.
- **1.8** There will be no compensation for transportation costs.
- **1.9** A list of hotels is enclosed.

# 2. Presentation

All horses are shown in hand. Only one handler per horse may be in the ring at a time. Helpers may not be positioned next to the ring. There will be no rattling of plastic bags. Foals between one and six months of age will be led by a halter together with their dams and stood before the judges. When the ring steward asks for movement, the foal may be turned loose, provided the mare is in the ring. After the individual presentation, it must be caught, and should be led by the halter for the announcement of the results.

#### 3. Entry fees

The entry fee is 85,- € for breeding classes, 60,- € for each sport horse, liberty, or gelding classes. In case of insufficient entries, classes may be merged or cancelled.

3.1 Stable reservations are to be made along with the entries and will only be accepted upon receipt of 125 Euros (including 1x bedding) per stable. Entry fees and stable money will not be reimbursed after the closing date. Additional bedding and hay may be purchased on the showground. Equipment must be brought.

# 3.2 <u>Entries not accompanied by the entry fees will not be accepted, this includes entries on commission.</u>

If entries are accepted past the closing date (postmark), an additional service fee of 40 Euros per horse will be charged.

- **3.4** Even in case of last minute changes, entries and stable reservations can not be withdrawn after the closing date. Exchanging an already entered horses is only possible until the closing date.
- **3.6** Every horse participating in the show must have an equine passport to enable a definite identification by the disciplinary committee.

## 4. Special prizes and qualifications

**4.1** Ribbons are awarded according to the placing:

1st place: gold ribbon 2<sup>nd</sup> place: silver ribbon 3<sup>rd</sup> place: white ribbon 4<sup>th</sup> place: blue ribbon 5<sup>th</sup> place: red ribbon

**4.2** Class winners and medal winners received special prizes. Any additional prizes are subject to the organizer's discretion.
